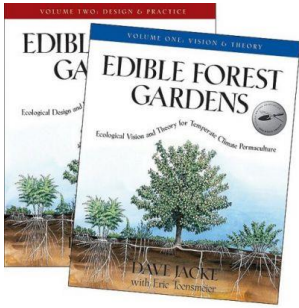
***Payment and Refund Policy:** A deposit of AUD \$50 is required to confirm a course place. The deposit is part of the course fee. If you withdraw from the course giving at least two weeks’ notice, we’ll provide a refund minus \$50. If you withdraw from the course after December 1, 2018, no refund will be given. You can, however, transfer your place to a friend or family member. If we need to cancel the course for any reason, you will receive a full refund, including your deposit. To qualify for Early Bird discount ALL fees must be paid by the relevant due date. Late payments remove eligibility. All students will be sent information on implementing Community Supported Education to support their attendance. Course numbers are limited to 18 participants. Any registration payments received after the course is full will be fully refunded and students will be placed on a waiting list.

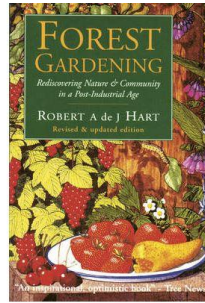

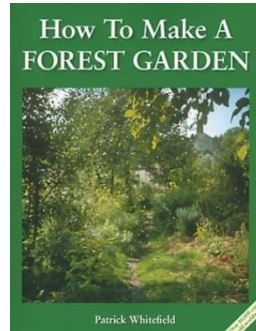
